Hello,

A serious road danger issue was highlighted at last night's residents meeting.

It was stated that the traffic lights on the right hand side on the Glasheen Road junction with Hartlands Avenue are completely blocked from view approaching from the west with overhanging trees on at least 3 properties (Paray Le Monial, Annsgrrove and the house next door which doesn't have a nameplate).

Please see attached photos which show the obstructions, the lights on the right hand side are not in any way visible as you approach the junction.

We request that you instruct the owners of these properties to cut back these trees/hedgings as soon as possible. If not we would expect City Council to cut away this danger themselves.

This is a serious traffic hazard to both motorists and pedestrians and is an accident waiting to happen.
