

House Parties – Magazine Road/Glasheen Road and greater College Road areas.

An Garda Síochána, City Council and The HSE are acutely aware of the disruption caused to residents in the Magazine Road, Glasheen Road and greater College Road area, by a small number of residents engaging in house parties.

On last Wednesday, 10th June, Chief Superintendent Barry McPolin and Superintendent Colm O’Sullivan of An Garda Síochána, together with Ann Doherty Chief Executive Cork City Council and Brian Geaney, Director of Housing, Cork City Council, met with Ms. Catherine Clancy and Mr. Aidan Cahill of The Magazine Road and Surrounding Area Residents Association at Anglesea Street Garda Station and a constructive meeting was held.

The Association was very appreciative of the efforts made to date by the Agencies in addressing their issues but are concerned that the problems will remain through the summer period.

Dr. Ann Sheehan, Specialist in Public Health, Chief Superintendent Barry McPolin, An Garda Síochána, Cork City Division and Ms. Ann Doherty, Chief Executive Cork City Council have, on behalf of the three statutory agencies, jointly written to each of the landlords in the area asking for their co-operation in addressing and reinforcing the statutory Regulations and Government Guidelines to stop the spread of the COVID-19 disease.

The letter has been delivered to each landlord and it is hoped that the landlords will actively engage with their tenants to ensure compliance with the Regulations, adherence to the Guidelines, and address the concerns of the residents with those minority of tenants who have engaged in such behaviour in these challenging times for our communities.

Liaison is also continuing with Social Welfare, Revenue and the PRTB.

The statutory agencies acknowledge the co-operation received to date in addressing the concerns of the residents.
